I do believe you can honestly convey to all of your future hunters that you offer a true and challenging classic western hunting experience within what equates to a select gated community that keeps the predators and poachers at bay while maintaining a trophy sanctuary with cover that in many cases – you cannot see past 20 yards! I personally witnessed game trying to get into your property – not out!! Such as Moose for example, and who can blame them with the great cover and feed available and the thick vegetation available. Trust me hunting in Texas under a game feeder timed to go off 3 times a day that has the game hypnotized to appear like clockwork is by far much less of a fair chase environment.
